

This document provides information about the new/improved features and production bug fixes delivered in the Mintec Analytics v4.3.1 release.

## What's Changed

#### The ability to sell/subscribe to individual price forecasts

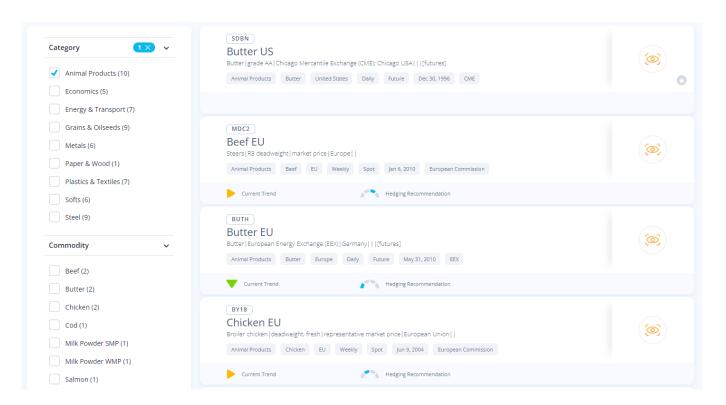
The key feature of this minor release addresses a commercial need to allow clients to subscribe to individual price forecasts, in addition to the existing options of all forecasts or at the forecast category level. When setting up a forecast subscription, the back-office system has been updated for individual price forecast selection.

Any clients subscribed to individual forecasts will see differences in Mintec Analytics, as follows:

#### Forecast Overview & Search

- o On the forecast overview screen, you will see the categories and forecasts you are subscribed to.
- The Forecast search screen will show all the forecast categories/commodities in the facets on the left.

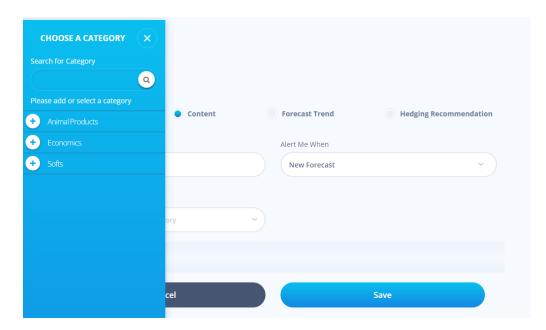
Any commodities you are not subscribed to will be displayed with a lock in the search results.



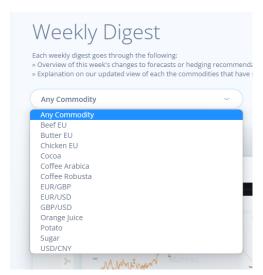
#### **Forecast Alert Notification**

- o You will receive forecast alert notifications only for the price forecasts in your subscription.
- o The ability to personalise alerts via Alert Centre is restricted to those categories/price forecasts within your subscription.





Weekly Digest: Only subscribed-to forecast commodities are listed in the Weekly Digest search selection.



**Forecast Add-In and API** allow the download of price forecast data the client has subscribed to. An error message is received if you try to download anything outside of your subscription.



## **Bug Fixes:**

**BUG #1:** Previously, it was not possible to add an imported index series to a cost percentage model. This has been fixed.

**BUG #2:** When exporting a cost model as PDF/PNG, any pinned values or text boxes didn't show in the download – this has been fixed.

**BUG #3:** Sometimes forecast categories were not displayed in the correct order on the Forecast Overview screen. This is now being handled correctly.

**BUG #4:** A number of translations have been corrected.

**BUG #5:** The issue when opening the weekly digest video from the mobile app has been fixed.
